

PAYPAL PAYMENTS

Our guild is moving forward! MVQ now has a PayPal account associated with our website and connected to our Santander bank account. Currently we have 2 situations where you can use PayPal:

You do not need a PayPal account to make these purchases. PayPal accepts most credit cards. PayPal is just the platform we are using to collect funds.

For those members and friends that do not wish to use a credit card, you can print a membership application and mail it to Linda Lydecker with a check. And you can still contact Betty Hastings if you wish to purchase tickets using cash or check.

The board decided to use PayPal as a way of contactless purchases at this time of isolation. Also, it is easy for non-members to purchase tickets or apply for membership. The Board tested the transactions several times and it is easy and simple. There is a fee associated with PayPal, but we receive a discounted rate due to our 501C3 status.




