
#### **NEW ENGLAND QUILT MUSEUM**

**Quilt Entry Forms:** Layne is now accepting quilt entry forms. You can find the form on the website. **Print it off, fill it in and send it to her**. If you plan on having a quilt(s) judged, be sure you enclose your check (\$5 for each quilt). If you plan on submitting more than one, please number your forms in priority order in the upper right-hand corner in case we receive too many to hang. Layne's mailing address is on the form.

# All items discussed below should be brought to the church on set-up day which is Thursday, September 30.

**Penny Raffle Baskets:** We encourage everyone (individually or as a group) to donate a basket for the Penny Raffle Table. We suggest **a theme basket**, for example, dog or cat related, Pasta/Italian theme, movie night, etc. Baskets do not need to be quilt themed. All baskets must be wrapped in cellophane with a list of items in the basket attached. Please let Mary Lou Monteiro or Margaret Tipton know of your intent to donate a basket and, if you have decided, what the theme will be.

Lottery Tickets and Fat Quarters: As in the past, we will also include a lottery ticket tree and a fat quarter basket on the Penny Raffle Table. Your donations are appreciated. Contact Mary Lou or Margaret regarding your donation.

**Silent Auction:** We are planning on having a varied and distinctive offering of silent auction items and that depends on you. **Handmade items** generate the most bids but all items will be accepted. Your donation should be valued at \$30 or more. The Silent Auction is being chaired by Susan Nelson and Gigi Badolato.

**Boutique:** Here is an opportunity to sell some **handmade crafts or other quilting items**, while supporting our guild. The guild receives 20% of the item's price and you receive 80%. Zoom Meeting Call to order: 7:01 P.M.

**President's Announcements:** March guild meeting minutes are accepted as circulated. Treasurer's Report accepted as circulated.

Cathy Harnisch is monitoring the chat room.

We have made the decision not to have in-person meetings until September.

At the April guild meeting, we start the election process for nomination of the executive board. Layne Rando, Nominating Committee Chair, will present at the next meeting. We will use Election Runner May 12-18 to cast votes. Paper ballots will be sent to the few who don't have email. Liz thanked Layne and committee for getting a full slate: Lynette Pisani, President; Jamie Ruh, Vice President; Maggie Judd, Secretary; Diane Kelley, AP Treasurer; Layne Rando, AR Treasurer. We had no other offers for nomination. Liz asked if there were any questions.

**Quilt Show** – Diane Kelley: Three full color ads are already sold for the show booklet. Lolly has our first vendor. Diane talked about needing things from the members: Penny Raffle Baskets, Silent Auction, and Special Exhibit. Linda Lydecker talked about being a member in good standing. Everyone has to work a minimum of 2 hours at the show. There are 174 slots to fill. She is using "Sign-up Genius" to sign people up for jobs. Sign-up Genius will send a confirmation, which can be changed if needed. It will also send a reminder 2 days before the event. Diane talked about hanging the red and white quilts in the gym and in the atrium.

**Programs** – Judy Naylor: This month's raffle basket brought in \$160. Betty Hastings won the basket. Judy is open to suggestions for the next two basket themes. Bev Valle suggested "Quilter's Delight" and Judy like that idea. The May speaker backed out so she found Linda Martin Mills to speak at the May meeting. There will be no workshop. 




