TLC Medallion Quilt (28" x 28") -- Supply List

Learn to use The Learning Curve Ruler (TLC)
Workshop taught by Linda Warren

In this class, you will make a small quilt top, starting with a 12" block in the center, and adding two pieced borders made with The Learning Curve ruler. You will learn how to use TLC ruler to make perfect circles and other curves with infinite design possibilities.

WHAT TO BRING

Basic sewing supplies: sewing machine and accessories, thread, medium or small rotary cutter, cutting mat, basic rulers (6x6, 6x12, 6x24 or similar), pencil and paper.

One 12.5" block (12" finished size).

Your block should measure 12.5" unfinished. It can be ANY block. Options include:

- Cut a 12.5" square from a panel or large-scale print.
- Use an orphan block leftover from another project.
- Make a block from any book or pattern.
- Make one of the blocks shown on The Learning Curve instructions. (This can be done as part of the workshop. Bring extra fabrics and expect to finish your top at home.)

Four fabrics to coordinate with your block

Fabrics	Suggestion	Amount	
1 (Innermost)	Light RAS*	1/4 yd or 1 FQ*	*RAS = Read as Solid
2 (contrast with 1)	Medium Print	1/4 yd or 1 FQ*	*FQ = Fat Quarter
3 (contrast with 4)	Dark RAS*	3/8 yd or 1 FQ*	
4 (Outermost)	Multi Print	3/8 yd	

The fabrics: **More is always better**. Bring extra options if you have them, and Linda will help you choose what to use where. The fabric suggestions above are just what I used in my sample. You can choose any fabric combination that coordinates with your block. You can even be scrappy. **The goal is to have enough contrast to show off your curves!**

Optional: You can add additional borders later to make a larger quilt.
