A: 1 1/2 yards
B: $11 / 8$ yards
C: 1 1/4 yards
D: $11 / 8$ yards
E: 7/8 yard
F: 1 2/3 yards
Backing: 3 3/4 yds
Batting: $65^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Tips

WOF is width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvages and squaring strip ends.
Label pieces with the letter/number combo given in the cutting steps. At the end of the cutting instructions are labels you can pin/clip to your cut pieces to help you keep them organized. The $D F, V, W, X, Y$ and $Z$ labels will be used in future months.

## Cutting

Fabric A (dark)

- 2 strips 14 " x WOF
- Sub cut into (4) 14 " squares and (2) $71 / 4$ " squares.
- Sub cut the 14 " squares twice diagonally to make 16 Altriangles. (Label A1)
- Sub cut the $71 / 4$ " in half diagonally to make 4 A2 triangles. (Label A2)
- 6 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for border.

Fabric B (medium)

- 11 strips $17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (I only needed 10 strips)
- Sub cut into (48) 1 7/8" x $5^{\prime \prime}$ B1 strips (Label B1) and (96) 1 7/8" B2 squares (Label B2).
- 6 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for border.

Fabric C (medium)

- 6 strips 2 3/4" x WOF (Label C1).
- 7 strips $21 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF for binding (the pattern calls for $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inches, but I like mine to be 2 $1 / 2$ inches so that is what I used)

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Fabric D (medium)

- 3 strips 5" x WOF (Label D1)
- 2 strips $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (Label D2)

Fabric D (continued)

- 6 strips $15 / 8$ " x WOF
- Sub cut into (40) $15 / 8$ " x $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ D3 strips (Label D3) and (40) $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ D4 squares (Label D4)

Fabric E (dark)

- 6 strips $21 / 4$ x WOF
- Sub cut into (48) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ E1 rectangles (Label E1)
- 5 strips $17 / 8$ x WOF
- Sub cut into (96) 1 7/8" E2 squares (Label E2)

Fabric F (light)

- 5 strips 2 3/4" x WOF
- Sub cut into (40) 2 3/4" x 5" F1 rectangles (Label F1)
- 2 strips $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (Label F2)
- 6 strips $15 / 8$ " x WOF
- Sub cut into $4015 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ F3 strips (Label F3) and $4015 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ F4 squares (Label F4)
- 11 strips 1 7/8" x WOF
- Sub cut into (48) 1 7/8" x 5" F5 strips (Label F5) and (96) 1 7/8" F6 squares (Label F6)
**** If you want to get a little head start on next month's prep - draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all of the $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{B} 2$, E2 and F6 squares.
