

Month 2 of the MVQG Mystery Quilt pattern. Thank you for participating.

Use 1/4" seam allowance.

Assembling units X, Y and Z

Gather the pieces needed:

B1

B2

E1

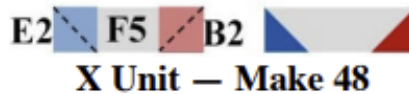
E2

F5

F6

1. If you did not do this last month, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 1 7/8" B2, E2 and F6 squares.

2. Place a marked E2 square on 1 end of an F5 strip and a marked B2 square on the opposite end as shown. Sew on the lines. Trim seam allowance 1/4" out from the stitching. Press the E and B corners open to complete (1) 1 7/8" x 5" **X** unit. Repeat to make 48 **X** units. (Label **X**)



3. Place a marked B2 square on 1 end of an E1 strip and a marked F6 square on the opposite end. Sew on the lines. Trim seam allowance 1/4" out from the stitching. Press the B and F corners open to complete (1) 2 1/4" x 5" **Y** unit. Repeat to make 48 **Y** units. (Label **Y**)



4. Place a marked F6 square on 1 end of an B1 strip and a marked E2 square on the opposite end. Sew on the lines. Trim seam allowance 1/4" out from the stitching. Press the F and E corners open to complete (1) 1 7/8" x 5" **Z** units. (Label **Z**)



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
