Elianna Urena from Lazarus House

Elianna provided an overview of the Lazarus House ministries. It is a faith-based program that has been serving people who are struggling with food, housing and clothing insecurities since 1981. The program operates a soup kitchen, shelter, thrift store and transitional housing. The transitional housing consists of 20 furnished apartments. Each apartment is supplied with a welcome basket which includes several basic items to help the family during the initial time there.

Lazarus House is looking for quilts for the 20 winter program cots which are approximately a twin size. They would like quilts for the 20 transitional housing units. The sizes for these units would range from crib, toddler, twin, and full-size beds.
