Month 5 of the MVQG Mystery Quilt pattern. Thank you for participating.

Use 1/4" seam allowance.

- 1. Gather your V, DF, W, D1 and C1 units.
- 2. Sew a V unit to the top of each DF unit, stopping and locking stitches 3/4" from the right corner of the DF unit as shown. You will finish sewing this seam in step 6. Press seam toward the V unit.



3. Stitch a W unit to the left edge of the pieced unit. Press seam toward the W unit.



4. Add a V unit to the bottom. Press seam toward the V unit.



5. Fold the loose end of the first V unit up out of the way. Sew a W unit to the right edge of the pieced unit. Press seam toward the W unit.




6. Align the end of the first V unit with the top edge of the pieced unit and finish the partial seam to complete (20) 5" x 5" center units. Press seam toward the V unit.





7. Stitch a D1 strip lengthwise between 2 C1 strips to make a 9 1/2" x WOF strip set. Press seams toward D1. Repeat to make 3 strip sets. Crosscut the strip sets into (40) 2 3/4" CD segments.



8. Sew an F1 rectangle to opposite sides of each center unit to make (20) 5" x 9 1/2" center rows. Press seams toward the rectangles. Stitch each center row between 2 CD segments to complete (20) 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Twist blocks. Press seams toward the CD segments.
